Re: Kodak Alaris and Deforestation- Free Products (EU) 2023/1115

To whom it may concern,

On 29th June 2023, the Regulation on deforestation-free products entered into force. The main driver of these processes is the expansion of agricultural land that is linked to the production of commodities like cattle, wood, cocoa, soy, palm oil, coffee, rubber, and some of their derived products, such as leather, chocolate, tyres, or furniture:

Kodak Alaris EHS has evaluated this regulation for applicability to our products. We have determined that it does not apply to our Thermal Media kits and receiver material (although the receiver is FSC Certified). For the limited number of products where there is applicability based on Annex 1 of the regulation, we are pursuing confirmation from our suppliers that the fibers are sustainably sourced and do not contribute to deforestation as per the regulation.
