

Almost all Kodak Alaris products are supplied with packaging to avoid damage before reaching end-users and to ensure restricted substances are not present. Our company designs packaging for reuse wherever practicable and to minimize environmental impacts whilst providing optimum protection, such as avoiding PVC, reducing types of plastics, and maximizing recycled content, etc.

Nevertheless, not all packaging can be reused and must be collected and treated appropriately when it becomes a waste. Kodak Alaris maintains a database with all packaging information for every product placed on the market including weight, composition and recycled content.


We are members of several national compliance schemes and using sales files combined with the database regularly submit packaging reports and pays fees in the obligated countries. For example, in the UK Kodak Alaris Limited is a member of compliance scheme Ecosurety and is registered with the national Environment Agency **NPWD280648**.
